Cranleigh Drive

Northern side from the Eastern kerb line of Councillor Lane for a distance of 15 metres in an Easterly direction and to tie in with the aforementioned on this side of Councillor Lane.

Southern side from the (projected) Eastern kerb line of Councillor Lane for a distance of 14 metres in an Easterly direction and to tie in with the aforementioned on this side of Councillor Lane.

Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

To report on an objection which has been received to a Traffic Regulation Order.

2. BACKGROUND

The legal advertising process for No Waiting at Any Time restrictions (see attached drawing number: **NM8-5127-001**) at the junction of Councillor Lane with Dryden Avenue and Cranleigh Drive has resulted in a single objection from a household on the latter.

The objection can be summarised as follows: The extent of the restrictions is excessive and will cause a displacement of parking with related problems for residents.

In considering the objection, the Corporate Director (Place Management & Regeneration) would state that objection could be deemed as having some merit - as the mouths of the respective junctions on either side are unusually wide. Therefore, the extent of the double yellow line restrictions has been revised to that shown on attached drawing number: **NM8-5127-001A**. Note: The local Ward Councillors have expressed a willingness to proceed on this basis.

Northern side from the (projected) Western kerb line of Councillor Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a Westerly direction and to tie in with the aforementioned on that side of Councillor Lane.

Southern side from the (projected) Western kerb line of Councillor Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a Westerly direction and to tie in with the aforementioned on that side of Councillor Lane.

Cranleigh Drive

Northern side from the Eastern kerb line of Councillor Lane for a distance of 15 metres in an Easterly direction and to tie in with the aforementioned on this side of Councillor Lane.

Southern side from the (projected) Eastern kerb line of Councillor Lane for a distance of 14 metres in an Easterly direction and to tie in with the aforementioned on this side of Councillor Lane.
