

Notice of Application for a Review of a Premises Licence under Section 51 Licensing Act 2003

Notice is hereby given that Trading Standards at Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council, a Responsible Authority within the meaning of the Licensing Act 2003 has applied on 12 January 2022 to Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council for a review of the Premises Licence in respect of the premises known as **Drinks Allowed / Go Local 18 Castle Street, Edgeley, SK3 9AD (premises licence number 18/01726)**

The grounds for the review are:

- Failure to meet the Licensing Objectives of The Prevention of Crime & Disorder, Public Safety and Protection of Children from Harm. In that complaints have been received regarding illicit sales of tobacco and alcohol. The premises licence holder was at the premises and the owner of a vehicle parked at the rear of the premises containing quantities of illicit cigarettes, illicit hand rolling tobacco and illegal vapes.
