The benefits of singing for people with dementia and their carers are well recognised. In 2021 the Drop-in applied for and received a small amount of funding to pay for a singing teacher to lead singing for fun sessions at the Drop-in. The funding enabled us to pay for a total of 6 sessions. Each session being held every 6 weeks. These sessions have been well received by people attending the Drop-in and compliment the other activities we offer which include film shows, seated exercise classes, outside speakers etc. Our final funded singing for fun session is on the 1st of April. As these sessions have been so well received, we wish to continue to provide singing for fun sessions and are seeking funding to pay for a further 6 sessions.

10. Who will benefit from this grant?

People with dementia and their carers who attend the Marple Dementia Drop-in will benefit.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

Prior to us having to suspend the Drop-in because of the COVID pandemic, there were regularly between 35 – 60 people attending the group each week. Numbers have been smaller since we re-started, but we are now starting to see more new people with dementia and their carers asking to come to the Drop-in.

10(b) Are there any restrictions on who will benefit from the funding?

Anyone affected by dementia is welcome to the group including older and younger people living with dementia, family carers and formal paid carers.

We are seeking funding to pay for a professional singing teacher experienced in managing dementia choirs to run 6 singing for fun sessions at a cost of £60 per session.

11(b) Tell us about other any other sources of income you have already applied for or raised so far in relation to this project

In 2021 we applied and received funding from Stockport Local Fund. This money was used to fund

- an Easter gift for people who normally attended the Drop-in but were unable to do so because of COVID
- to pay for support worker sessions to help run the drop-in when it resumed in August 2021
- a small number of singing for fun sessions
 Our last funded singing for fun session is on 1st April, which is why we are now seeking additional funding for a further 6 sessions.

We are applying for £360

£360 will allow us to continue to provide singing sessions on a 6-weekly basis for the remainder of 2022. Because of the benefits of these sessions for people with dementia, we are keen to continue to give people attending the group the opportunity to engage in this type of specialist communal singing. Beyond 2022 we will apply to other funding bodies to support this activity.
