#### Signage - Bramall Hall

Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

#### 1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek approval for the supply and installation of new signage in relation to Bramall Hall.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1. The Local Ward Councillors have received several concerns in relation to larger vehicles driving down Bramhall Park Road and Carrwood Road to access Bramhall Park. As Bramall Hall and Bramhall Park have become more successful, it is essential that we direct the larger / heavier vehicles, including coaches visiting Bramall Hall down a preferred route away from Bramhall Park Road to avoid Lady Brook Bridge which has Traffic Regulation Order for 3 Tonne maximum weight restriction and has signs informing drivers that it is a 'weak bridge'.
- 2.2. The Local Ward Councillors have also received requests from two of the local scout groups in the area. Both groups have highlighted difficulties members of the public, including potential new members, have encountered when trying to find their respective buildings and therefore, have requested advanced directional signage to alleviate this problem.

# 3. PROPOSALS

- 3.1. To resolve the concerns raised, Traffic Services propose to install a number of new signs. These proposals are show in **Drawing Nos. NM36-Bramall Hall-01 Rev A**, **NM36-Bramall Hall-02, NM36-Bramhall Hall-03, NM36-Bramall Hall-04, NM36-Bramall Hall-05 and NM36-Bramall Hall-06.**
- 3.2. These concerns have been shared with Bramall Hall who have kindly agreed to contribute 50% towards the costs of the new signage.
