The Council introduced a Public Space Protection Order in 2018 to promote responsible dog ownership. Public Space Protection Orders were the replacement for Dog Control Orders which were phased out in 2014. PSPOs are time limited. Following a public consultation the intention is to replicate the previous PSPO for a further three years in line with the relevant legislation.
