Summary:

This Scrutiny Review was jointly commissioned by CRMG and Adult Social Care & Health Scrutiny Committees. The Final Report and Recommendations were considered by Cabinet on 27 April 2021, and it was agreed to prepare a response.

Since the Final Report was approved, significant progress has been made against delivering the recommendations. The opportunity has therefore been taken to provide an update in addition to a Cabinet Response against these recommendations.

Comments/Views of the Cabinet Member:

I'd like to endorse the recommendations from the review which are closely aligned with our priorities in working with our health partners and providers. Significant progress has been made in delivering these recommendations over the last ten months, including the launch of our One Health and Care Plan and development of shadow Integrated Care System arrangements ahead of full implementation in July.

The evolving ICS arrangements build on strong relationships with our health partners to drive delivery of new models of care and our ambitions for tackling longstanding inequalities. It is our intention to bring a further update on implementation and governance arrangements to Scrutiny Committees in June alongside this response.
