7 hanging baskets supplied by Plantscape @ £40 = £280. Watering for the entire summer/autumn season @ £40.70 x 7 = £284.90 **Total £564.90**

£500 applied for from SMBC Climate Now Fund to enable us to plant wildlife friendly plants with local schools. We are also approaching local businesses/retailers for contributions to enable us to increase the number of hanging baskets and encourage ownership of the voluntary work we do. Notcutts have also provided discounted bulbs and plants, as well in kind advice and labour for the larger plots.
