Ward councillors undertook to raise the matter with officers in Traffic Services to determine a way forward on this issue.</i></p> <p><b>19 October 2021</b> <i>Data was requested from Traffic Services in relation to the speed indicator device placed on Bean Leach Road, Offerton.</i></p> <p><b>30 November 2021</b> <i>Members commented that the Speed Indicator Devices on Bean Leech Road had been removed, and an update was requested from Highways regarding the status and location of the device.</i></p> <p><b>17 January 2022</b> Officers confirmed that an email had been sent to Members in relation to the Speed Indicator Devices across the borough and an update would be provided in due course.</p> <p><b>25 January 2022</b> <i>Members raised that there had been no progress in relation to the 'pinch point' on Bean Leach Road and no report had been provided.</i></p>	Jon Brown
