1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To approve the cost for a traffic design and feasibility study on Dale Street in Edgeley

2. BACKGROUND

2.1. Network management received representation from the highway ward spokesperson that had concerns and had also been approached by several residents to a number of safety concerns that had been raised about the road, such as a lack of preventative speed measures. Discussions with Highways Officers in regard to the appropriate course of action to improve road safety. It was proposed that the study be undertaken by Highways Officers, with funding from the Area Committee's Delegated Budgets (Davenport & Cale Green / Edgeley & Cheadle Heath allocation) to cover the associated costs.

3. CONSULTATIONS

3.1. The Local Ward Councillor Spokespersons for both wards have indicated their willingness for a report to be submitted to approve the associated costs. No affected frontages in this area.

4. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1. The associated cost for a design study by the Feasibility and Road Safety Team (FaRST) would be £1,000 split funded between the following delegated Ward Budgets;
