We would like to apply for funding to run a stall at “Summerfest 2022” in Heaton Moor Park on Sunday 10th July. The funding will be used to print some A5 flyers, a large banner and a couple of reusable laminated maps of the Heaton. Summerfest is a popular, free, family-friendly, community-focused event, which will provide an excellent opportunity for us to engage with the community about how they can make short local journeys more sustainably. We will have information about local walking and cycling routes, including those being currently built/planned by the Council as part of the Bee Network. Please note that the actual stall is being provided free of charge, as we are a voluntary group, and the banner and maps will be reusable at future activities/events in the Heaton.

The event is free for all members of the local community to attend – old, young, families, disabled people. Our group has a wide range of knowledge and experience about sustainable and active travel within the Heaton and can help to advise visitors to Summerfest on how they can start to make their local journeys more enjoyable and healthier and reduce the number of short journeys they make by car. This will be beneficial in helping to address the Climate Emergency declared by Stockport Council in 2019.

There are around 29,000 residents in the Heaton North and Heaton South Wards, although people may also attend Summerfest from outside the local area.
