

**NOTICE OF AMENDMENTS TO THE EXECUTIVE SCHEME OF DELEGATION
(DEPUTY CABINET LEADER (DEPUTY LEADER OF THE COUNCIL), THE
CABINET, AND THE ALLOCATION OF RESPONSIBILITIES)**

Report of the Chief Executive

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To give notice of amendments made by the Leader of the Council to the Executive Scheme of Delegation in accordance with the provisions of Section 9E of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Council's Constitution (PR3 – Executive Procedure Rules).

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 A written record of the delegations of executive functions is set out in Part 3 of the Constitution
- 2.2 Rule 1.4(a) of the Cabinet Procedure Rules provides that “the Cabinet Leader may amend the scheme of delegation in so far as it relates to Executive functions at any time during the year, by giving written notice to the Chief Executive”.
- 2.3 Rule 1.4(b) further provides that “the notices given by the Cabinet Leader and the Chief Executive will set out the extent of the proposed amendment to the scheme of delegation, and whether it entails the withdrawal of delegation from any person, body, Committee or the Executive as a whole”.
- 2.4 The Chief Executive must then present a report to the next ordinary Council Meeting setting out the changes made by the Cabinet Leader

**3. DEPUTY CABINET LEADER (DEPUTY LEADER OF THE COUNCIL), THE
CABINET, AND THE ALLOCATION OF RESPONSIBILITIES**
