

One Stockport Health & Care Locality Board Quality Flash Report for the period to July 2022

Items to Note:

- Stockport's Primary Care Quality Group met on Wednesday 6th July. The GP practice visiting programme for 22/23 is well established. With areas of learning identified that can be advised to all practices. All GP practices have received an update on the ICS arrangements as the Masterclass session at the end of June.
- The Stockport Primary Care Board is in the process of being established.
- The first formal meeting of Stockport's Quality Improvement Collaborative is 14th July.
 There have been a series of development sessions to agree principles for working and terms of reference. The SQIC will report directly to the Stockport Locality Board as well as GM SQG.
- There has been a Care Home Workshop to establish the strategy for Care Home and Home Care Provision across Stockport. The workshop focussed on several strategic areas including quality improvement, workforce, estates, market management, seamless services with NHS providers especially Discharge Processes to maintain people's safety
- Stockport's Integrated Quality Strategy (IQS) is being prepared completion date 30th September. The Stockport Provider Partnership will be asked to contribute to the development of the IQS
