Summary: The Neighbourhoods Service have received an application from Circus Starr to hold their circus in Torkington Park on Saturday 10th June 2023 from 1.30pm – 5.30pm. Access to the site is required from 9th to 11th June.	
Circus Starr is a Community Interest Company which provides local disadvantaged children with a show that they are able to attend with all the family at no cost. Tickets are distributed through local charities and schools. In 2022 local organisations which distributed tickets included: Lisburne Special School, Follow Your Dreams, Stockport SEND Families, and Jumpspace.	
The Circus visited Torkington Park for several years pre-pandemic and returned again in 2022. The Circus has invested in enhancements to make their shows more accessible, including a Mobiloo Mobile changing places facility, a BSL Interpreter and in 2023 are updating their popular sensory packs which are sent to children with sensory impairments in advance to prepare them for the sensory changes they may experience at the show.
