We have been funded by The National Lottery to continue delivering our physical activity sessions - walking with litter picks in local green spaces, weekly squash and tennis sessions. The funding includes project management, community engagement and feedback sessions and equipment. The activities are aimed mainly at the LGBTQIA+ community in Stockport but also open to allies, friends and family. We have been running the activities of the past 2 years and they have greatly benefitted those who have taken part.

The funding does not however, include refreshments for during and after the activities (usually a coffee and sandwich)

10. Who will benefit from this grant?

The whole LGBTQIA+ community in Stockport. Our community has poor rates of physical and mental health and isolation. By bringing people together to connect via physical activity we are helping to improve their lives.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

Our reach is beyond what we can measure in numbers - even those who do not take part are encouraged by our existence. The community in Stockport is around 20,000 but we activity engage with around 200. Everyone in the borough benefits as we do litter picks in different areas making it a clean and safe environment for residents and wildlife.

Anyone within the LGBTQIA+ community, their friends and families.
