After cancellations and an adapted programme of events since 2020, Heatons Arts Trail are in the early planning stages of returning to our original format of a weekend long Arts Trail within the four Heatons to take place 1st and 2nd July 2023. We are a not for profit organisation giving local artists a platform to showcase their work to a local audience as well as network with other creatives. We are seeking funding towards new promotional material – specifically new banners and flags to raise awareness of our event locally within the Heatons and also the wider Stockport community in order to reach new audiences.

The beneficiaries of this grant will be local artists, designers and makers who will be given a chance to showcase their talents and build relationships with their local community. The local community of Stockport and beyond will benefit from engaging with a positive arts community, be able to learn new skills through taking part in workshops and get insight into an alternative career path.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

Before the pandemic our artist participation figure was 60 of which 90% were Stockport residents. The number of local visitors were approx. 500

10(b) Are there any restrictions on who will benefit from the funding?

There is a selection process to take part with priority given to local artists as well as artists, designers and makers being full time professionals rather than hobbyists.
