We run an Adult active session every Monday Morning from 10:30 – 12:30. It takes place at Stockport Power League; we would like to add to our sit down exercises that we do.

We would like to add Thera bands, Resistant band, and dumbbell exercises, this would help all our participants improve on their flexibility, strength, stamina and overall health and fitness. This would take place indoor area at the venue.

We deliver outdoor activities for the group on the 5 aside football pitches. We do some football, handball, throwing and catching, invasion games as well as hand eye coordination games with the group. The equipment is needed for the participants to challenge themselves, also improving their health and fitness. The participants will improve their hand eye co-ordination as. The equipment will provide us to deliver more varied sessions for the participants. Building on the skills and fitness from week to week to keep them challenged mentally and physically.

In addition, we would require further funding to hire the venue to deliver the County Adult Group we the venue is accessible due to the public transport links and the free car parking. In the summer we take the group on therapeutic walk and talks as the Mersey Trail in located at the back on the venue.

Local older Adults aged between 30 - 60 – They will benefit from this equipment by increasing their weekly exercises. It will be an improvement from what we are doing now with just body weight exercises as they can test themselves.
