At Make Build Grow we believe that art and creativity are powerful tools for positive change. We empower people to transform their lives. We do this by giving opportunities to achieve and succeed, learn new skills, grow, and be seen and heard through artistic, DIY, up-cycling and creative processes and projects that promote wellbeing.

We are opening a new space called 'MakeGood.' in Cheadle Heath, Stockport that will be open to all to provide a warm space, brews, snacks, good chats, and the opportunity to create and learn new skills and connect with others. We will be offering a monthly community repair cafe to repair and repurpose as well as weekly furniture up cycling and DIY workshops for care leavers and women.

We are in the process of cleaning and painting our new space, and getting it ready so that we can deliver our art, craft, upcycling and DIY projects from there. As well as a drop in repair shop run by volunteers and a tool library for people to borrow tools from, for their own projects.

We currently run creative workshops with unemployed women, and refugee, asylum seeking, migrant women to connect, share skills and improve wellbeing and confidence.

We also run art in nature sessions with young carers, young people with Autism, and asylum seeking/migrant families

We run junk art workshops with young people of all ages all over Stockport- turning junk into art or new objects and have just received funding to buy some specialist tools for children to support this work.

We are also really proud of our Do-It -4 your-self project where we work with care leavers in Stockport to develop their DIY and home maintenance skills and up cycle their own furniture.
