2. About Your Application

9. Please give us a brief description of your proposed/planned project or activity

Replacement of a 7 metre length of boundary fencing that separates the Seven Stiles Allotment from the public footpath.

Background

The fence separates the allotment and public footpath. In this area there is a steep bank down into the allotment where there is a stream and culvert.

We have two concerns about this fencing:

Firstly the path is starting to breakaway and only some old chain link fencing is preventing a person or small child slipping down into the allotment. The footpath is extensively used by parents taking children to and from the junior school, children from the secondary school and walkers going through to the canal and Brabyns Park.

Secondly it is a security risk for the allotment in that anyone with intent could push their way into the allotment site.

A new fence was installed some ten/twelve years ago but at that time this seven metre stretch was covered by chain link fencing with dense bushes behind. This area was the left in the understanding that it was good for some years to come, that was approximately 12 years ago and inevitably this section has now deteriorated.

This work is beyond the capabilities of the allotment members and needs to be undertaken by a professional fencing contractor.


