Kew Drive - Bollards

Report of the Director for Place Management

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1. To seek approval for the introduction of Bollards on the south side of Kew Drive, Cheadle Hulme.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1. The Council's overall strategic transport ambition is to increase the number of children walking or cycling to school. In order for this to be achieved, it is important that there are safe route options for children and their families. A Road Safety Around Schools scheme has been carried out for Cheadle Catholic Primary School. Following the consultation and objections being received. Any changes to Kew Drive where omitted from the proposals.
- 2.2 Traffic Services have met with local councillors to tackle key concerns which have been raised local residents.

3. PROPOSALS

- 3.1. To reduce the impact of inconsiderate parking 10 bollards it is proposed to be installed on the southern footway of Kew Drive.
- 3.2. The installation of bollards on the southern footway will reduce the width below recommendations and guidance. The northern footway will remain unobstructed.

4. CONSIDERATION OF ALTERNATIVE SOLUTIONS

- 4.1. Alternative options have been provided in March 2022 Objection report 3.21. https://democracy.stockport.gov.uk/ieListDocuments.aspx?Cld=149&Mld=27490
- 4.2. Slimmer bollards where investigated to allow a wider unobtrusive width, however there were no highway specific bollards available to accommodate this.

5. CONSULTATION

5.1. The Local Ward Councillors have directly requested this work to be undertaken.

6. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

6.1. The estimated cost of the scheme is as follows:

Installation of 10x bollards £5,000

TOTAL £5,000

6.2. The scheme will be funded from the Cheadle Hulme South ward delegated budget.

7. TIMESCALES

7.1. Should the proposals be approved, the scheme should be ready for implementation in Summer 2023.
