# (i) DC/079856 - The Rope Works, Stanbank Street, South Reddish

In respect of plan no. DC/079856 for the variation of Conditions 1 (Approved Plans) and 28 (Opaque Glazing) attached to planning permission DC063392 in relation to minor changes to the existing permission in relation to Building A (improve the efficiency of the layout for the mill building conversion, retaining more of the fabric of the original building and providing a glazed link between the retained features) and Building B (increase in height of building along with changes to car parking layout) at The Rope Works, Stanbank Street, South Reddish, it was

RESOLVED – That planning permission be granted.

## (ii) DC/085817 - Seaton House, 61 Wellington Street, Stockport, SK1 3AD

In respect of plan no. DC/085817 for the conversion and extension of the existing Seaton House, together with the construction of a new building to the rear to provide 35 dwellings (Use Class C3) with associated partial demolition, access, parking and landscaping at Seaton House, 61 Wellington Street, Stockport, SK1 3AD, it was

RESOLVED – That the Deputy Chief Executive and Corporate Director for Corporate & Support Services be authorised to determine the application subject to a legal agreement that would require a reassessment of viability at a later date to enable claw back should the viability position change over the course of the delivery of the development.

DC/086482 for the demolition of existing outbuildings to erect 3 detached single storey dwellings with the retention of the existing flora cottage and single storey extension to flora cottage following demolition of existing conservatory at Flora Cottage, 438 Chester Road, Woodford, Stockport, SK7 1QS, it was

RESOLVED - That the Deputy Chief Executive and Corporate Director for Corporate & Support Services be authorised to determine the application subject to the applicant entering into Section 106 Agreement for open space contributions.

# (iv) DC/087393 - Edward Street, Stockport, SK1 3DQ

In respect of plan no. DC/087393 for the variation of condition 1 (approved plans) of planning permission ref: DC/073782 for a revised design and access solution and reduction in number of dwellings to 131 from 133 at Edward Street, Stockport, SK1 3DQ, it was

RESOLVED – That the Deputy Chief Executive and Corporate Director for Corporate & Support Services be authorised to determine the application subject to a legal agreement relating to highway matters.

# (v) DC/087687 - 130 Moor Lane, Woodford, Stockport, SK7 1PJ

In respect of plan no. DC/087687 for a two storey side and rear extension and single storey rear extension at 130 Moor Lane, Woodford, Stockport, SK7 1PJ, it was

RESOLVED – That planning permission be granted.

# (vi) DC/087683 - 75 Newlands Avenue, Cheadle Hulme, Cheadle, Stockport, SK8 6NE

In respect of plan no. DC/087683 for a single storey rear extension, external alterations including modifications to front porch, conversion of garage, pitched roof over existing two storey side extension, alterations to driveway and boundary treatments at 75 Newlands Avenue, Cheadle Hulme, Cheadle SK8 6NE, it was

RESOLVED – (10 for, 2 against) That planning permission be granted.

## 7. PLANNING APPEAL, ENFORCEMENT APPEALS AND ENFORCEMENT NOTICES

A representative of the Assistant Director - Legal & Democratic Governance (Monitoring Officer) submitted a report (copies of which had been circulated) summarising recent appeal decisions, listing current planning appeals and dates for local inquiries and informal hearings according to area committee.

It was reported that since the publication of the report, the date of compliance for the enforcement notice at Fern Cliff, 18 Mauldeth Road, Heaton Moor had not been complied with and there was no work being undertaken to show compliance, therefore enforcement officers had provided one month to undertake the works prior to legal action being taken.

The following comments were made/ issues raised:-

- It was noted that a number of the updates remained on the report and requested that a revised list be provided within the agenda for the next meeting of the Committee.
- In relation to the replacement of trees, it was queried what action was taken by officers
  to monitor enforcement. In response, it was stated that if action was not taken to
  replant the trees in accordance with the enforcement notice, officers would issue court
  proceedings and where the trees were not replanted, officers would seek an injunction
  where the trees would be planted by the council and seek costs.
- In relation to the Planning Appeal at 30 Hampstead Lane, Stockport, it was queried whether the site was located in Stepping Hill Area Committee.

RESOLVED – That the report be noted.
