## Purpose of the report:

To provide the board oversight of the final position at the end of the spring covid vaccination programme.

## Key points (Executive Summary):

- Eligible Cohort - People aged 75 years and older, residents in care homes for older people, and those aged 5 years and over, with a weakened immune system will be offered a booster vaccine this spring.
- Stockport had full Primary Care Network (PCN)/GP Surgery opt in, which enabled us to continue delivery in our preferred model for delivery.
- Stockport Locality achieved an overall vaccine uptake level of 67.7%, the target for this programme was 60%.
- Stockport was the highest performing locality across Greater Manchester (GM) overall, but also in all three categories – Care Homes, Over 75s & Immuno-suppressed.
- Lessons learned identified.
