Report of the Director of Place Management

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To rectify an administrative error.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1. On Thursday 9th March 2017, the A6 MARR Team submitted a report to the Bramhall & Cheadle Hulme South Area Committee which included works on Gillbent Road, outside the Co-op where a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) was to be introduced; a half-width lay-by was to be provided to provide short-term parking close to the shops together with 'No Waiting Monday-Saturday 7.30am-6.30pm restrictions' (single yellow line). However, the TRO process was not completed in full; whilst the lay-by has been constructed, the lining and signage work installed onsite is not correct and the Order has not been sealed. This means that Civil Enforcement Officers are unable to carry out parking enforcement at the location.
- 2.2. Too much time has now elapsed for the sealing of the Order. Therefore, in order to address this administrative error, and to correct the lining & signage works, we need to start the TRO process from the beginning.
- 2.3. A Network Management Officer has visited the Co-op located on Gillbent Road and spoken to a staff member who has confirmed that they have no concerns relating to the times of the limited stay bay. However, they do have concerns relating to vehicles parking within the limited stay bay all day, sometimes for days at a time, and with no parking enforcement being carried out. The Officer informed the staff member of the administrative error and advised them that until the administrative error has been rectified the location cannot be enforced by the Councils Parking Team.

3. PROPOSALS

3.1. This is not controversial and therefore, it is proposed to introduce the Traffic Regulation Order as was intended in 2017. These proposals are shown on the updated **Drawing No. 1013-Gillbent Road-2023-01**.

4. LEGAL POSITION/IMPLICATIONS

4.1. The Traffic Management Orders would be made under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Council is required by the Local Authorities Traffic Order (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 to give notice of its intention to make a Traffic Order (by publishing a draft traffic order). These regulations also require the Council to consider any representations received as a result of publishing the draft Order.

5. CONSULTATION

- 5.1. As previously mentioned in 2.3, a Network Management Officer has spoken with the Co-op.
- 5.2. There will be no letter drop however, this will be advertised in the normal way with the Notices displayed in the local newspaper, on-street and on the SMBC website.

6. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

6.1. There will be no financial impact to the Cheadle Hulme South delegated ward budget. This scheme will be wholly funder by the A6 CMMM Budget.

7. TIMESCALES

7.1. 3 months, subject to objections.

8. EQUALITIES/COMMUNITY IMPACT ASSESSMENT

Traffic Regulation Order Schedule

Revocation of Traffic Regulation Order 'No Waiting Mon-Sat 7.30am-6.30pm'

Gillbent Road, Cheadle Hulme - Northwest Side

From the south westerly kerb line of Hulme Hall Road, for a distance of 86 metres in a south westerly direction.

Proposed Traffic Regulation Order 'No Waiting Mon-Sat 7.30am-6.30pm'

Gillbent Road, Cheadle Hulme - Northwest Side

From the south westerly kerb line of Hulme Hall Road, for a distance of 23 metres in a south westerly direction.

Gillbent Road, Cheadle Hulme - Northwest Side

From a point, 47 metres southwest of the south westerly kerb line of Hulme Hall Road, for a distance of 39 metres in a south westerly direction.

Proposed 'Limited Waiting to 30 minutes, no return within 1 hour, Mon-Sat 9am-5pm'

Gillbent Road, Cheadle Hulme - Northwest Side

From a point, 23 metres southwest of the south westerly kerb line of Hulme Hall Road for a distance of 24 metres in a south westerly direction.
