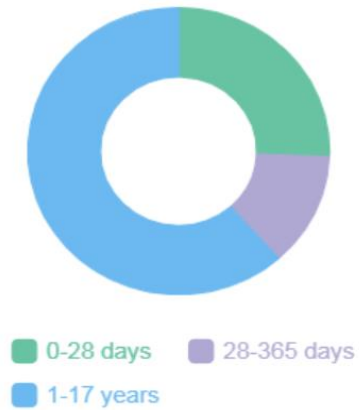
Stockport, Tameside and Trafford 2021-22

Deaths reported

We were notified of 39 deaths in 2021/22

- This is below our 8-year average of 48
- There isn't (yet) a clear trend towards a lower notification rate
- 10 were neonates (below 28 days) and a further 5 were aged under 1. 24 children died between age 1 and 17

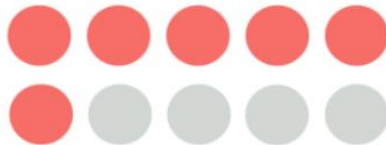


Infant deaths

Birth weight and gestation

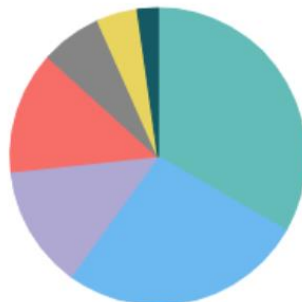
54% of infants who died had a low birthweight and 56% of infants who died were premature

Chromosomal, genetic and congenital abnormalities	15
Perinatal/neonatal event	12
Cancers	6
Trauma/injuries	6
Acute medical / surgical condition	3
Sudden unexpected unexplained death	2
Chronic medical condition	1

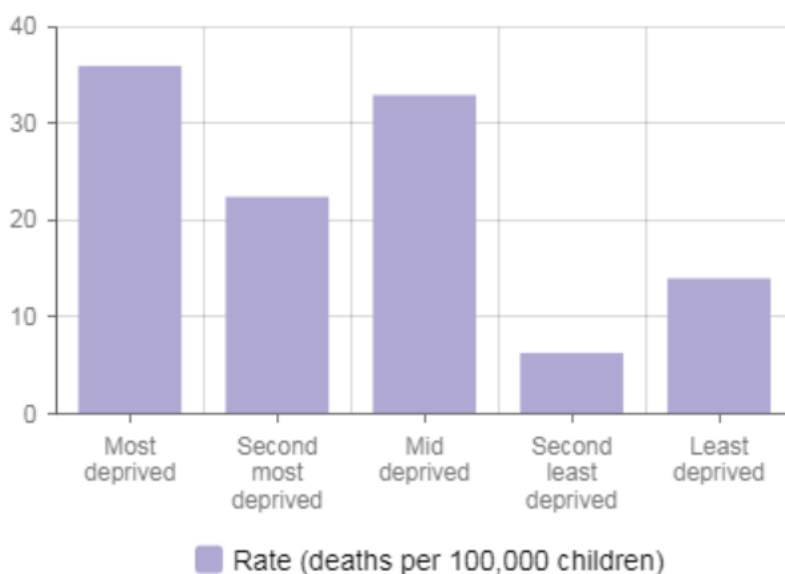

Deprivation

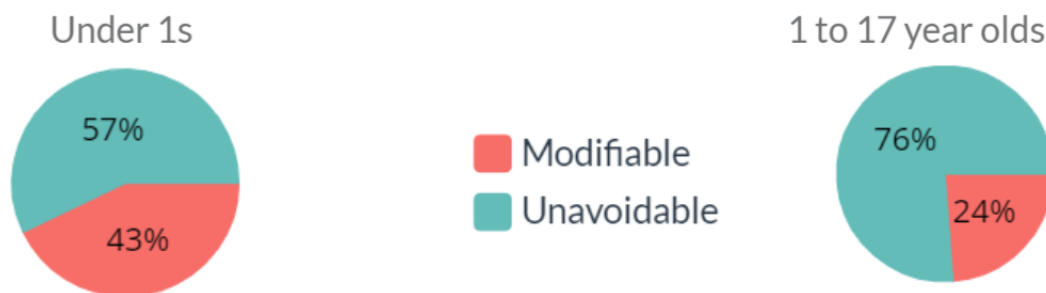
Deprivation increases risk
