We plan to deliver Stockport's first ever celebration of Diwali with our Indian residents. And a weekly drop-in /meet up for our Indian community. The Diwali event will take place at Edgeley Park County Football Park. The regular drop in and meetups will take place across Heaton Norris, Cheadle, Cheadle Hulme, Gateley and Bramhall.

The event and drop-in are targeted at the Indian community but also would welcome from all people of all backgrounds to learn about each others' cultures.

We want to support and develop residents of Indian heritage background. There is currently no provision in the whole of the Stockport borough specifically for the Indian community. More recently we have an increasing number of Indians in the borough as well as those who have lived here for the past 30-50 years.

All ages will benefit from this grant as we will be providing activities e.g. crafts, arts, poetry, singing, musical instruments, dancing, story-telling, journaling and educational workshops.
