The Middewood Station Adopter, David Buxton, has worked with Eamonn Murphy to develop a plan for using existing artwork of local community buildings and has also requested new artwork to be completed of the Boars Head, a family friendly pub which is close to the station on the Middlewood Way.

These artworks will be displayed at the station. There is currently no artwork.

10. Who will benefit from this grant?

It will significantly enhance the station for the community and for those visiting Middlewood.

It could attract new rail users with promotion of the project.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

All rail users of services which pass through Middlewood, but mainly those who live in the area and use the train services. Pre-covid, the station had 21,000 entries and exits recorded. This reduced to just over 7000 during the pandemic and recent statistics are not available.

10(b) Are there any restrictions on who will benefit from the funding?

Station access could restrict benefits to some people with disabilities. The station does not have step free access. https://www.nationalrail.co.uk/stations/middlewood/
