We plan to hold a Family Fun Day at end of Cricket Season in September 2023 bringing players, non-players, volunteers, families, friends, local community including people that live around the cricket ground to learn and play cricket.

HMVCC will use the grant to organise a family day community event at the cricket ground in Heaton Mersey involving various children cantered activities and adult participation. We will get young people to perform dancing and African drumming, raffles, children's entertainment and information stalls from local charities and community group stalls. The award is for hiring of chairs, refreshments and cricket bats, soft balls and other sporting equipments that will be used all season both indoors and outdoors by young people at the club. Pay for PA costs, security, St John's Ambulance, children's clown, trampolines, bouncy castle and refreshments.

With what is remaining from grant we will be used for refreshments during our planned monthly health awareness self support talks for cricketers and non cricketers on health issues that affect more of the African and Caribbean men and women like Prostrate Cancer, Diabetes, Sickle Cell, Menopause, and Mental Wellness.

Men, women, older people, young people, local residents borough wide, and general public. No entry fee will be charged and it will be all inclusive fun event.

We hope to attract about 200 people to the event from all communities.
