### 6. Please describe the main activities of your Organisation/ Group

Arts Central Youth Theatre Group is a not-for-profit voluntary theatre community group for children aged between 8 and 15 living within some of the most deprived areas of Stockport. (All of the children reside in Reddish, Edgeley, Brinnington, Heaton Norris and Gorton). We celebrate and promote young people expressing themselves creatively with others, recognising the benefits this can bring. We run from September through to March each year culminating in a big showcase production demonstrating their skills and achievements and we do not charge the children to part in our initiative.

Our group prides itself on inclusivity for all and we reach families who may not be able to afford activities like this for their children. We have a proportion of children with additional needs such as autism and ADHD who benefit hugely from our sessions as well as teenagers and young adults from the LGBTQ+ community. The children gain enormous skills from acting, singing, dancing, technical theatre and working as part of a group and we see this from the day they join. Increase in confidence, making friends, positive mental health and for some it is the only social interaction they have (outside of school) where they can be themselves and embrace the safe environment we provide.

Arts Central Youth works with communities, organisations, , funders and creative individuals as a voice for positive change, to improve and expand the landscape in which creative participation can take place. We work to address inequalities in access to creative participation, promote inclusivity, connect people and communities, and seek to increase awareness of the links between creativity and wellbeing.

Arts Central Youth Theatre Group gives young people the opportunity to learn through play, perform throughout the year and participate in a wide range of art forms. It also helps to develop important skills such as communication, team building, problem solving. Strengthening their confidence (or self-belief), emotional Intelligence (or ability to empathise with others), resilience (or ability to respond well to

stress and/or pressure), teamwork and leadership skills, emotional wellbeing, broadened horizons. A number of features of the youth theatre experience particularly contribute to these outcomes: Skills development inherent in the creative activity; nurturing facilitation; supportive environment / community. In combination, these features create a system of continual positive reinforcement meaning that any outcomes of the experience become embedded in the individual as personal values — thus having a lifelong influence and leading to the positive long-term impacts on personal lives and careers.
