Feel Good Feminist Fightclub is a community interest company based in Stockport that puts on women's only events promoting mental and physical well-being. Ultimately, we help women along their personal journeys to self-acceptance and love – this is achieved through a variety of activities, including creative outlets, body movement, mindfulness, reflection, talks from successful women in their field and other cultural activities. We also signpost the help and resources that are available for women facing various challenges, as well as being a pillar of support and networking for women. Our first event was in September 2023 and was a roaring success – the day consisted of a bookbinding workshop, self-love inspired journaling, lunch and open discussion time, a gratitude exercise, and an hour of mindful and meditative yoga. The next event is upcoming on the 28th October and will include ceramic pumpkin painting, reflection aimed oracle readings and movement focused laughter therapy. Currently, the community needs to pay for these events through ticketing.

The event I would like to apply for funding for, is the event we hope to put on for World Women's Wellness Day on 27th April 2024 at Heaton Norris Community Centre. It would be a full day event, from 11am – 5pm, free to women of the Stockport community to get involved in activities that will promote general wellness – including physical, mental, and emotional wellness. The day will include a variety of activities, including but not limited to: yoga, dance classes, breathwork, mindfulness, meditation, various crafts and inclusive of food and drinks.

Local female residents within the Stockport area will benefit from our events. Events will be open to all local women of ALL backgrounds, regardless of religion, age, race & sexuality. This demographic will benefit from allowing themselves the time to spend on something purely for themselves, that will promote physical and mental well-being as well as a sense of community. Their introduction to Feel Good Feminist Fightclub will also provide them with an ongoing network of supportive, likeminded women to share challenges women of different backgrounds may have faced in the past and could face in the future. The event will be inclusive of different cultures, providing a range of different activities.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

For the proposed event, approximately 60 people could benefit, as well as countless more benefiting from the ongoing events of the club and its network of self-love, well-being and support. Attendees that will benefit can come from any of the wards.

The events we propose are limited to women only.
