Summary:

The Neighbourhoods Service has received an application from Crazy Legs Events to repeat their successful Stockport Trail Half Marathon event on greenspace along Middlewood Way from a start point at Wood Lane car park, Marple. The route then goes through High Lane and into Cheshire East and land owned by the Canals and Rivers trust. This is an annual event which has been held for several years. The event will be held on 25th February 2024 between 9.30am -1.30pm with access required from 7am – 2.30pm. The organisers have agreed to ensure any litter is removed after the event.
