## **Additional Parking - George Street, Compstall**

### **Report of the Director of Place Management**

#### **1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 This report is to acknowledge the parking concerns on George Street, Compstall after a request from councillors.

#### **2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1. A request was received from ward members to look at available options for parking on George Street, in front of the Post Office. Currently there are four parking bays which can be used by anyone, with no time restriction.

#### **3. PROPOSALS**

- 3.1. There is an option to add an additional parking space in the area in front of the Post Office. This will give five potential bays, which could be used for limited waiting, permit parking or loading.
- 3.2. Options will be discussed further with ward members prior to consultation.
