1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

To update the Board on the One Stockport: One Future work and engage in a discussion on the main elements.

Background to this work

- The starting point for this piece of work has come from our One Stockport Borough Plan, which was launched in March 2021.
- Our Borough plan set out our shared ambitions for the whole borough, across all partners up until 2030. These shared ambitions comprised of 'One Heart, One Home, and One Future'
- The One Stockport Borough plan represents a significant accomplishment for the council and our partners, and we are well on the way to delivering remarkable things together as a Borough.
- But to build on this success, we need to think much further ahead, galvanising people around reasons why Stockport will be the best, and what we need to do collectively as partners across the Borough to achieve our vision of being the Best Place in Britain to live a happy and healthy life.

Purpose

- This piece of work is focused around the 'One Future' ambition from the Borough Plan and is intentionally future focused. Concentrating on change and action over the long term (15 years) for our borough.
- We have identified 5 big things that we will collectively deliver as a Borough over the next 15 years, that will transform our Borough. We want all our partners on board with these 5 big things.
- This work is a 'call to action' that will promote and showcase our strengths and local assets to both government and external agencies.
- This is to help secure the support and resources we need to deliver these 5 big things to realise the Borough Plan's overall vision and full potential

Engagement plan and key dates

- The development of One Future: One Stockport will be done collaboratively together with our partners and stakeholders
- It is critical for our residents to understand our plans and key ambitions for the borough, and part of understanding is being able to relate to the things we are speaking about.
