Report of the Director of Adult Social Care

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Adult Social Care are developing a Technology Enabled Care (TEC) approach that will enabled us to deliver on the ambitions set out in the One Health & Care Plan and the Council Plan. It will be aligned to the commissioning strategy within Adult Social Care and the Councils digital strategy.
- 1.2 The purpose of this presentation is to share with the committee the work we are doing in Stockport to increase the use of Technology Enabled Care and to share a demonstration of the Virtual House which will be launched in the coming months.

2. TECHNOLOGY ENABLED CARE

- 2.1 Over the next five years our vision is to provide more opportunities to deliver personalised, cost effective care and support using digital solutions and data insights that promote independence for individuals. This will help us to effectively manage demand and financial resources as well as promote independence for individuals.
- 2.2 To achieve this we will need to adopt a ONE Stockport approach, working in partnership between care, health, housing and the VCSFE sector.
- 2.3 It is our ambition that by 2027/28 70% of individuals supported in the community will have access to Technology Enabled Care (TEC).
