# Arundel Avenue, Hazel Grove - Installation of a Bench

#### Report of the Director of Place Management

# 1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

To approve the cost and installation of a bench seating facility near the shops on Arundel Avenue in Hazel Grove.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

In agreement with the local Ward Councillor Spokesperson, an opportunity has been identified for the installation of a bench in the landscaped area near the shopping parade on Arundel Avenue. This would aid vulnerable or elderly pedestrians who are visiting the shops and need a rest.

The location and specifications for the bench are shown on **Drawing Number: NM18-6394**. Note: The shopkeepers and immediate households will be notified before the facility is installed.

#### 3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The associated cost for the bench would be £3,000 funded from the Hazel Grove Ward Discretionary Budget.

# 4. TIMESCALES

If approved, the facility is expected to be installed within a period of 3 / 4 months.
