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A.C.E inclusive delivered a local pilot test and learn SEND project as part of ongoing development within our equity, diversity, and inclusion standards.

12 weeks of combined engagement and delivery with parents and carers of children with SEND/additional needs. The focus of which was offering parents/carers respite, whilst offering children a provision meeting as many of their needs in advance.

This partnership with caregivers taught us the need for engagement prior/during/after the project. We have successfully delivered the first of it's kind in terms of a dedicated community SEND provision.

The Local pilot delivery of a community led inclusive club has led us to identify what more needs to be done at a local level. It is our promise to promote inclusivity at every opportunity. By raising awareness of inequality from our position, we are actively working with the local councils and other large organisations to shape those changes.

A.C.E. have created a community of coproduction forum with parents/carers and their children to help them take their rightful place in society, by way of collaboration and education, working together to promote positive change in real time. As a grassroots organisation, collaboration is at the heart of everything we do, our learning is shared with our community.

ACE INCLUSIVE seek to tackle, both through our own #sendsuperstars programmes continued evolution, but more importantly through working in parallel and partnership with all local sports providers, and VCSFE partners in this geography.

15 children attended the club on a Saturday morning at Bridgehall Primary School, delivering a series of child focused physical activity and sensory workshops.

We follow a parent/carer led approach to ensure the continuation & impact of our inclusive offer.
