Op: Hive is an opportunity to build, set up and manage our own apiary. The intention is to promote biodiversity, ecology and improve mental & physical health amongst the veteran and civilian community of Stockport. Whilst the charity is veteran focused, we see an opportunity for civilian and veteran integration with a shared goal of working together in a Hive like community. There will be engagement and opportunity for local experts to pass on knowledge of bee keeping and teach the practicality of physically building bee hives in the grounds of RECCE HQ and learning how to care for the bees as well as producing honey & wax.

#### 10. Who will benefit from this grant?

e.g. local residents, young people, older people and how?

The Project RECCE community is now national with over 600 veteran beneficiaries, but the Charity firmly has its roots in Stockport. Beneficiaries of the charity frequently return to pay forward their knowledge and employment opportunities and many have expressed an interest in attending a course on building bee hives, bee keeping or volunteering time to help others. All the ambassadors over fifty and growing, have offered to support Op:Hive which will benefit them or their mentees as well as the local residents/communities that attend the hive building and bee keeping courses.

#### 10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

We expect 20-50 Stockport residents will <u>directly</u> benefit but it could be argued that the whole of the borough benefits as the majority of flowering plants rely on pollinators to reproduce. Fruits and vegetables all rely on pollinators transporting pollen from one flower to the next. But the value of bees goes beyond just supplying countless fruits and vegetables. The top 5 reasons why bees are important, they:

- Help produce 1/3 of our food supply
- Help provide ½ of the world's fibers, oils, and other raw materials
- · Help create many medicines
- · Provide food for wildlife
- Help prevent soil erosion
