Please give us a brief description of your proposed/planned project or activityYou may wish to include details of what activities will take place, where will it happen, how often and who will take part. If you are applying for equipment you can tell us what will it be used for and why is it needed.

We run regular weekly and monthly meetings including poetry workshops and visits to cultural venues (such as galleries, libraries and museums). We help members of Persian speaking communities have access to the Persian literature e.g. by running poetry workshops and book exchange programmes. We run book clubs where we read together as well as providing opportunity for people to recommend further readings and share their knowledge. We have sessions in English and Persian so English speaking community members who would like to join us can do so. In this way we help with integration in the society.

In our annual celebration we collaborate with academics, local artists and other local cultural groups to celebrate diversity and to learn from each other. This year our annual celebration falls in the 12th May and will be held at Rethink Rebuild Society Discovery House, SK4 5BH.

We run our sessions for free and rely on members who can pay to cover some of the costs for those who are unable to pay by asking people to donate. In the past we have worked with Sahba (a music academy based in Manchester), Commonword (a writing organization based in Manchester), Doosti (a support group for refugees and migrants based in Salford), Sheba (a women-led community arts organisation based in Manchester working with refugee and migrant communities). We have also worked with academic such as Professor Charles Melville, Dr Firozeh Melville and Dr Mahmood Kavir who have offered their supports in kind. We also collaborated with publishers from London to showcase their Persian books in our event.

Since 2021, when we first had our Zoom accounts, we ran 127 free poetry workshops and 20 annual or larger free public meetings most of our activities were full to the capacity.

Most of our costs include:

- The cost of running our annual events:
 - -Advertising, designing and printing leaflets
 - -Hiring a venue for annual session
 - -Refreshments
 - -Expenses for our speakers
 - -Technical support for sound and PowerPoint
- The cost of running our on-line events:
 - -Annual subscription of zoom
 - -Annual domain cost for website
 - -Annual subscription for hosting website

10. Who will benefit from this grant?

We are a unique group running sessions in English & Persian, so language barrier issue in Persian speaking communities is addressed. Local residents interested in exploring other

cultures, Persian speaking communities of migrant and refugee backgrounds (ie, Afghan, Tajik, Arab and Iranian), adults of all ages, families, second generation migrants who want to learn about their heritage are all examples of community members likely to join us and benefit from this grant.

We are sending the leaflet to over 300peple in Stockport area. In the past most of our activities were full to the capacity. We even had sessions where over 200 people attended. Last year we hired a smaller venue to keep the cost down. Many people were disappointed not to be able to join us. This year we can accommodate 130 people.
