

**WARD DISCRETIONARY BUDGET**  
**Installing a Defibrillator**

Report of the Director of Place Management

**1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 The report sets out a request for additional funds to support the installation of a defibrillator at The Strines Nightingale Public House on Strines Road SK6 7GE from the Ward Discretionary Budget with a request of £250 to instal the defibrillator

**2. BACKGROUND**

The Strines Nightingale on Strines Road is a privately owned Licensed Premises and has been extensively refurbished recently and the current owners have funded the purchase of a new defibrillator. The request for £250 is to cover the cost of installation. Every minute without CPR and defibrillation reduces a victims survival rate by 7-10 per cent without immediate treatment 90-95 per cent of cardiac arrests prove fatal . Marple South and High Lane Ward Cllrs support the funding.

**3. RECOMMENDATION**

- 3.1 The Area Committee is recommended to comment on the allocation of funding and to request that the Cabinet Member for Finance & Resources approves the use of £250 from the Ward Discretionary Fund (Marple South and High Lane £250) towards the costs of installing the defibrillator.
