Proposed blue plaque for the Grade II listed Crown Inn

The proposed position of this blue plaque on the Crown Inn is directly opposite an 18<sup>th</sup> building [Parr's House], now demolished. The blue plaque will be fixed 7 feet high and will be visible from Didsbury Road, the A5145. The plaque design is following a standard design of 8 other Heatons Heritage Society 19 inch blue plaques, all in the Heatons.

Permission to mount a blue plaque on the front of the Crown Inn from Robinson's Brewery has already been granted.

It will be installed professionally by either Robinson's Brewery or High Peak Engineering Ltd. There will be an unveiling of the blue plaque by an invited dignitary, at which everyone will be welcome to attend.

The plaque is to honour Admiral John Illingworth, born 1756, who is a National hero of the Ecuadorian War of Independence in the early19th century. Born Parr's House, Heaton Mersey, The SMBC Conservation Officer and the Ecuador Embassy support this project.
