**Summary:**

The Neighbourhoods Service has received an application from 4 Seasons Events Group to hold a Kids Adventure Kingdom Inflatable World & Childrens Funfair Event at Torkington Park from Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> August to Monday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2024.

The organiser has previously held this event in the park in August 2023 and May 2024.

The event is for children up to the age of 12 and will include inflatable attractions: a Helter Skelter, a Play Centre, and also more traditional rides and stalls: trampolines, bumper cars, a roundabout and Hook-a-duck stall.

Hot food and drinks will be available.

The event will be open from 11.30am until 5.30pm each day.

Access will be required from Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> August and the attractions will leave site on 27<sup>th</sup> August.
