**9. A School Street trial started at St Thomas' in May 2023. Initially supported by Stockport Council during the summer term, it has run almost entirely without any further support from the Council since September 2023. The School Street has very much been driven by the School and parents who wanted to change the chaotic nature of the school drop-off and pick-up and has run every single school day, both morning and afternoon. It is quite complex, involving 5 separate closure points and consequently 5 volunteers (parents and some local residents) are required to marshal it every morning and afternoon for 30 minutes. They collect the Road Closed signs/bollards, take them out to the closure points, ensure only legitimate vehicles are allowed to pass through (via a permit scheme) and then return the signs/bollards to the school.

The generic "Road Closed" signs we were supplied with by the Council are not very helpful in telling people about why the road is closed – marshals often have to explain why the road is closed. We would like to replace these signs with seven bespoke "School Street" signs, which include the closure times and make it clear that those who are walking/wheeling/scooting are welcome to pass through.

We regularly get thanked by parents, with some expressing concern about whether the project will continue. The Deputy Head at the Infants school has commented on the positive effect of the street closure – children arrive much calmer and can now safely walk, scoot or ride straight into school.

Stockport Council has undertaken two consultation exercises with local residents and parents of children at the school - one before the start of the trial period and the second towards the end. The results of the second consultation were very positive with overwhelming support for the School Street to continue.
