

WARD DISCRETIONARY BUDGET - HEATONS SOUTH

Report of the Director of Place Management

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 Request for the allocation Ward Discretionary Budget of £1,230 (Heatons South) for a Covid Memorial sculpture in Norris Bank Open Space.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Stockport Covid Memorial Fund provided investment to fund four new memorial seats within Norris Bank Open Space. Two of the benches were fitted with memorial plaques.
- 2.2 The memorial seats were installed in April 2024.

3. PROJECT

- 3.1 It is proposed to extend this works to install a slate hollolith stone sculpture with plaque in Norris Bank Open Space.
- 3.2 The sculptural stone will be placed on the grass embankment facing out on to Didsbury Road.
- 3.3 An example of the slate hollolith is provided as Appendix A.
- 3.4 The cost to supply and install the stone sculpture with plaque is £1230.00

4. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- 4.1 The Area Committee is requested to recommend that the Cabinet Member for Finance & Resources approves the allocation of £1,230 from the Ward Discretionary Budget (Heaton South) Norris Bank Open Space Covid Memorial.
