# Report of the Director of Place Management

# 1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

To approve amended Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs) on part of Chester Road in Hazel Grove.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

Network Management identified several anomalies with the parking restrictions (TROs) fronting No's 17 to 29 Chester Road. The markings on-site are not consistent with the TROs as mapped and a new order is required to consolidate the situation.

For information, the mapped TROs are shown on drawing number: **NM8-5238-001**. Note: The extent shown for permit parking is not appropriate as it would interfere with the junction leading to Grundey Street.

#### 3. PROPOSALS

It is recommended the restrictions as currently marked on-site remain unchanged; apart from the short length of single yellow line (No Waiting Monday to Friday 8.00am – 6.00pm) fronting No. 29 which can be upgraded to double yellow lines (No Waiting at Any Time) to prevent vehicles parking too near the junction. Note: There will be no changes to the current extent of the permit scheme as marked on-site.

In agreement with the Ward Councillors the proposal shown on drawing number: **NM8-5238-002** went to consultation with frontage properties. For information, the said single yellow line restriction fronting No. 29 is not mapped as a TRO and therefore will not feature as part schedule to be approved.

#### 4. LEGAL POSITION/IMPLICATIONS

The Traffic Management Orders would be made under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Council is required by the Local Authorities Traffic Order (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 to give notice of its intention to make a Traffic Order (by publishing a draft traffic order). These regulations also require the Council to consider any representations received as a result of publishing the draft Order.

#### 5. CONSULTATION

The consultation did not result in any feedback. This could be related to the fact that the covering letter explained the 'Ward Councillors support the scheme in principle'.
