Summary:

“Our vision is for all children and young people with SEND to have the best start in life. We want all children and young people to be happy, prepared for adulthood and able to achieve their goals. We want families to feel supported, confident, resilient and connected to their community”

Following the SEND Inspection of 2018 the SEND Strategy 2020-2023 was developed to support the delivery of the Written Statement of Action. After the 2023 SEND revisit, the written statement of action was signed off with an accelerated progress plan. Regular meetings have continued with the DfE.

The SEND Strategy 2024-2027 is a refresh of the previous strategy, co-produced between Stockport Council, NHS GM Stockport and SEND Partners, including but not limited to SEND Parent Carer Forum. Data from the SEND JSNA and the Investment Position Statement supported the identification of the key areas for prioritisation for the next 3 years.

The strategy contributes to the delivery of the Children and Young People Plan 2024-2027 which identifies seven Big Ambitions. The SEND Strategy delivers Ambition 4 but also works towards the other 6 Ambitions.
