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## Purpose of the report:

Highlight the progress of the Provider Partnership

## **Key points (Executive Summary):**

- At the July 2024 Provider Partnership, a deep dive report was presented for Diabetes. This presentation contained outputs from the workshop session, which was held in May 2024.
- Highlight reports were completed for Alcohol Related Harm, Frailty and Cardiovascular Disease (CVD), which provided updates of progress.
- Subgroups have now been established for all workstreams. These are being supported by the Primary Care Programme Manager from Greater Manchester (GM) Integrated Care Partnership and Strategy and Partnerships/Transformation from the Foundation Trust.
- A fifth-year placement Public Health Consultant will be joining Stockport and supporting aspects of the Alcohol Related Harm work.
- Actions from the meeting included:
  - CVD workstream NHS Health Check Programme mobilised and data to be presented to this meeting at a later date.
  - CVD workstream Links around target areas such as mental health, smoking cessation and better screening to be examined between partners.
  - Alcohol Related Harm The funding for a business case for an alcohol related harm nurse in ED to be discussed between partners and brought back to the meeting.
