Report of the Director of Adult Services

1. Introduction

- 1.1 A key finding of the LGA Peer Review was to develop a Co-production Action Plan based upon resident's feedback. Adult Social Care therefore commissioned an engagement piece with residents in Stockport who draw on ASC and their family, friends, and carers. The findings of this work form the basis of this Working in Partnership Action Plan.
- 1.2 People told us they prefer to use the term 'Working In Partnership' instead of co-production to show the importance of making decisions together and shared power.

- 1.3 The Making it Real Board are cited on this work and have contributed to its development.
- 1.4 The Working in Partnership Action Plan and Working in Partnership Good Practice Report have been presented to CLT.
