After the success of the alley clear up by the residents at Dona Street / Celtic Street we are organising a community clear up on Saturday 22nd June for the alley between Carnarvon Street and Courthill Street. It has been neglected for some time and has been attracting fly tipping, animal mess and just generally unsightly.

The council are providing refuge bags, litter pickers and rubbish removal free of charge. The goal is to clear all the weeds, rubbish, have a good sweep and hopefully create a space that we can all use. I have applied for a grant from the council that hopefully means we can buy some benches / planters / plants. I will keep you posted on that.

If you are able to help on the day, it would be great to see you. We will be starting around 9am but it will likely take most of the day, so join whenever is convienient. I have included the email from the council about safety for reference. If you have a brush, shovel, wheelbarrow, hoe etc please bring, it would be very helpful.


