All rooms have disabled access and the review has taken into consideration that there should be no barriers to voting for people with a disability.

There is no identifiable alternative that would be an improvement for electors in DC1 – DC8 and therefore no changes are proposed.

DC9 – This small polling district was created at the 2022 Polling Place Review to allow for the Electoral Registration Officer to continue to produce electoral registers on the old ward boundaries, as was a legal requirement at that time. This district has no registered electors and was created for administrative purposes to align old and current ward boundaries. As this is now superfluous, it is proposed to merge it into DC4.

DC10 – This polling district was created separate to DC4 due to the ward boundary change between Davenport & Cale Green and Brinnington & Central in 2022, allowing electoral registers for the old wards to still be provided. As there is no longer any need to produce registers on old ward boundaries, these districts do not need to be separate and is proposed to merge DC10 into DC4. Electors in this polling district will experience no change as they already vote at this station.
