**Resident Permit Parking Scheme on Kingsland Road & Ellesmere Road.**

The Council has been phasing out free Residents Parking for several years, these are done when there is a requirement for maintenance to either the road surface, road markings and signs making parking enforcement very challenging.

The existing council policy is to not maintain currently free parking schemes. This is because we are unable to continue to enforce free parking schemes within the available resources to the council. For free schemes, we rely solely on the signage having a discouraging effect on drivers rather than regular enforcement from our civil enforcement officers.

We wrote to all residents of both Kingsland Road and Ellesmere Road entitled to the free permit parking scheme, as we received requests for parking enforcement and maintenance to carry out this enforcement. These requests, therefore, triggered the policy to convert from a free to paid scheme consultation, which will allow maintenance and enforcement, if residents support a paid scheme.

Following a consultation exercise with residents of both Kingsland Road and Ellesmere Road in July 2023, the majority of residents support the move to 'paid' permits. However, during this same consultation, one main request from residents was for the permit parking area to be extended to cover the whole of the road as the existing bays were insufficient to accommodate residents vehicles.

Whilst we understand the problems residents encounter parking, we do have to consider the needs of the nearby businesses. With this in mind, we propose to extend the permit holder only parking to cover the whole road between the hours of 6pm to 8am (with the exception of the area protected by double yellow lines). However, to facilitate parking for the nearby businesses, between the hours of 8am to 6pm, it is proposed to provide short-term parking (1 hour, no return within 1 hour) for a maximum of 4 vehicles. These proposals are shown on **Drawing No. NM27-Kingsland Road-01 Rev D** and **Drawing No. NM27-Ellesmere Road-01 Rev D**.

To assist the authority in reaching a decision, we are consulting with both residential and nearby businesses and would ask that you please spend a few minutes to consider these proposals and indicate your choice on the form overleaf. Please include any comments you may wish to make on the proposals and return them in the enclosed **FREEPOST** envelope no later than **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2024**.

Please be advised that all comments will be considered as part of the overall consultation process; however, these will not be responded to individually.
