## **Proposed Traffic Regulation Order**

The Network Management Section has received a request from your local ward councillors to investigate parking in the area following concerns raised by residents; the concerns are that motorists are parking their vehicles close to the junctions. It is further reported that parked vehicles are hindering the movement of traffic and limiting visibility for other motorists and pedestrians.

To overcome these concerns, it is proposed to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) – 'No Waiting at Any Time', (double yellow lines) as shown on the enclosed **Drawing No. NM8-5089 -001.** 

The request for an investigation has been discussed with your local ward councillor responsible for traffic issues (Highway Ward Spokesperson), who has agreed to consult on this matter. Therefore, to assist the authority in reaching a decision, please could you spend a few minutes to consider the issue and indicate your choice on the form overleaf.
