

WARD DISCRETIONARY BUDGET - OFFERTON

Report of the Director of Place Management

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The request for the allocation of £2,430 from the Ward Discretionary Budget (Offerton) towards the purchase and install of three community noticeboards for the Offerton Ward.

2. PROJECT DETAIL

- 2.1 The standard parks noticeboard cost £600.00 each, with a total cost of £1,800.
- 2.2 The standard parks noticeboard is a metal post mounted board (powder coated aluminium).
- 2.3 The noticeboard is black with a robust plexishock glaze.
- 2.4 The noticeboard is 750mm x 750mm (can fit six A4 size sheets). Notices fit to the steel backboard with the provided magnets.
- 2.5 The installation of the noticeboards cost £210.00 each, with a total cost of £630.00.
- 2.6 The community noticeboards will be placed in Half Moon Lane Recreation Ground Offerton Community Centre and on the junction of Lisburne Lane / Blackstone Road.
- 2.7 The Lisburne Lane location is on Stockport Homes land and they have given their approval for the noticeboard to be placed here.

3. PROPOSAL

- 3.1 Allocation of £2,430 from the Ward Discretionary Budget (Offerton) towards the purchase and install of three community noticeboards for the Offerton Ward.
- 3.2 The works would be delivered within 8 weeks of funding approval.

4. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- 4.1 The Area Committee is requested to recommend that the Cabinet Member for Finance & Resources approves the allocation of £2,430.00 from the Ward Discretionary Budget (Offerton) towards the purchase and install of three community noticeboards.
